Piperaceae

Piper carolinense HOSOKAWA, sp. nov. (*Nematanthera*)

Dioicum? Scandens? Ramulus glaberrimus, striatus, ad nodos paullo incrassatus, internodiis ca. 4-8 cm. longis. Folia petiolata, petiolis glabris basi vaginantibus 2-2.5 cm. longis; laminae ovatae vel elliptico-ovatae, apice acutae, basi obliquae, acutae v. cuneatae v. obtusae, margine integrae, chartaceae, 5-plinervatae, nervo centrali paullo supra basin trifido caetero utroque uno e basi soluto, utrinque glabrae, supra opacae, subtus reticulatae, nervis paullo elevatis, ad 9 cm. longae 6 cm. latae. Amenta oppositifolia, densiflora, solitaria, pedunculata, pedunculo glabro ca. 1.2 cm. longo, parte florifero ca. 3 cm. longo. Flos ♂: bracteae pelta glabra, orbicularis, ca. 0.5 mm. in diam., centro breviter pedicellata. Stamen unicum, peltis bractearum paullo superans, antherā filamentis fere aequilongā.

HAB. *Caroline*: Palau, in a forest on the coral islet of Urktable, at middle altitudes (T. HOSOKAWA, no. 7505 ! X. 15, 1933—*Type in Herb. Taihoku Imp. Univ.*).

HAB. *Marianne*: Guam!—Rota, growing in luxuriance as a undergrowth in a primary forest near Sinapal, at low altitudes (T. HOSOKAWA, no. 7568 ! VII. 10, 1934),—Agrigan, in a primary forest at low altitudes (T. HOSOKAWA, no. 8011 ! VIII. 1, 1934).

paniculati. Paniculae sessiles, ca. 10 cm. longae, prope basin fasciculatim dispositae, rachibus velutino-tomentellis. Calyx late cupulatus, extus et intus adpresso tomentosus, 9 mm. longus 16 mm. latus, dente superiore obsoleto integro, dentibus infero-lateralibus late deltoides ca. 1.5 mm. longis, dente infero lanceolato-deltideo apice aceroso-acuminatissimo 9 mm. longo 5 mm. lato. Vexillum ovatum, glabrum, apice bifidum, 4 cm. longum 3.2 cm. latum. Alae falcatae, apice obtusae, prope basin extus pubescentes, stipitatae, stipitibus dense hirtellis ca. 5 mm. longis, 5 cm. longae 1.7 cm. latae. Carina valde incurva, quam alae angustior, apice acuta, glabra, ca. 5 cm. longa 1 cm. lata, stipite ca. 5 mm. longo. Stamina valde incurva, 5 cm. longa, antheris brevioribus barbatis 2 mm. longis. Ovarium dense ferrugineo-villosum, 8 mm. longum, stylo filiformi longe piloso inferiore 6 cm, longo.—*Proxima M. tomentosae* K. Schumm. in K. Schumm. u. K. Lauterb. Nachträge Fl. Deutsch. Schutzgeb. HAB. Caroline: Ponape, leaned on *Ficus carolinensis* WARB. by a riverside near Nampil (T. HOSOKAWA, no. 6036! VIII. 25, 1933—*Type in Herb. Taihoku Imp. Univ.*); in a *Campnosperma* forest at low altitudes of Mt. Nānaraut (T. HOSOKAWA, no. 5926! VIII. 22, 1933).

***Mucuna pacifica* HOSOKAWA, sp. nov.**

Alte scandens, ramulis in siccitate nigricantibus pilosis pilis demum deciduis. Folia petiolata, petiolis pilosis et hirtellis striatusculis 12–20 cm. longis. Foliola petiolulata, petiolulis dense hirsutis ca. 5 mm. longis; terminalia suborbicularia, apice abrupte acuminatissima vel cuspidato-acuminata, basi rotundata, margine integra, 5-penninervia, membranacea, supra in siccitate nigricantia, adpresso sericeo-pilosa, subtus dense adpresso sericeo-pilosa, pallidiora, laxe retiformia, costis et venis prominentibus, ad 14 cm. longa ad 11 cm. lata, lateralia oblique ovata, gibbosa, apice cuspidato-acuminata, basi truncata vel rotundata, caetera foliolo terminali similia. Flores ignoti. Legumen oblongum, supra pilis ferrugineis (tamen demum deciduis) dense vestitum, 2-3-seminiferum, in utrinque suturis bialatum, alis membranaceis ca 8 mm. latis, inclinatim lamellosum, lamellis membranaceis

3 mm. latis, ad 13 cm. longum, ca. 5.8 cm. latum.—Proxime affinis
ad M. Kraetkei Warb. [in ENGL. Bot. Jahrb. XIII. (1891) p. 329].

HAB. *Marianne*: Saipan, in a *Claoxylon* forest at about 300 m. above the sea-level on Mt. Tappocho (T. HOSOKAWA, no. 6725 ! VII. 17, 1933—*Type in Herb. Taihoku Imp. Univ.*); in a secondary thicket at middle altitudes of Mt. Tappocho (T. HOSOKAWA, no. 6684 ! & 6647 ! VII. 17, 1933); in a *Artocarpus-Barringtonia* forest at low altitudes of Mt. Tappocho (T. HOSOKAWA, no. 6605 ! VII. 17, 1933).

***Mucuna* sp. nov.?**

Scandens, ramulis nigricantibus filiformibus striatusculis pilosis. Petiolus longe sericeo-pilosus, ad 9 cm. longus, stipellis setosis 4 mm. longis, petiolulis dense hirsutis 3 mm. longis. Foliola terminalia membranacea, lanceolata vel ovato-lanceolata, apice caudata vel caudatim acuminate, basi rotundata, margine integra, 7-penninervia, supra laxe sericeo-pilosa, subtus subdensiora, ad 15 cm. longa 6 cm. lata; lateralia gibboso-obliqua, caetera foliolo terminali similia.

HAB. *Caroline*: Ponape, in a *Campnosperma* forest at low altitudes of Mt. Sankaku (T. HOSOKAWA, no. 5483 ! VIII. 8, 1933); in a *Campnosperma* forest at low altitudes of Mt. Nānaraut (T. HOSOKAWA, no. 5917 ! VIII. 22, 1933).

As the characteristical feature in this climber, in Ponape they will recognize the species with narrower leaflets which have always caudately acuminate or caudate apices.

***Derris mariannensis* HOSOKAWA, sp. nov. (*Paraderris* BENTH.)**

Frutex, ramis glabris, ramulis juvenibus dense ferrugineo-hirsutis. Folia 5-7-foliolata, petiolis parce pilosa, ad 9 cm. longa. Foliola opposita, petiolulata, petiolulis hirtellis 4-5 mm. longis; laminae elliptico-oblongae vel ovato-ellipticae, apice acuminatae mucronulatae, basi cuneatae rarius truncatusculae, margine integrae, chartaceae, 7-penninerves, utrinque pilosae, reticulatae, subtus costis et venis ferrugineis prominentibus, ad 7 cm. longae 4.2 cm. latae. Racemi axillares, quam folia breviores, ad 5 cm. longi, rachibus ferrugineo-hirtellis. Flores saepius geminati, pedicellati, pedicellis pubescentibus 6 mm. longis prope apicem bibracteolatis bracteolis minimis. Calyx cupuliformis, extus ferrugineo-pubescentis, ad marginem remotissime un-
